

The Fieldcrest CUSD 6 transportation department has been working throughout the summer to ensure all routes and shuttles are in order for the upcoming school year. Transportation Director Tom Heidenreich would like to announce the following.

1. Regular and special education rural bus routes will be similar to previous years. Drivers will be calling parents by Friday, August 11, with approximate times for riders on these routes.
2. **Shuttles between towns will leave each school at 7:45 AM daily.** Signs will be in the windows of buses to help students find their bus. It is recommended your child riding a shuttle arrive 10-15 minutes early. Shuttle staging will be as follows:
 - a. Shuttles from Minonk – load either at Primary School on Johnson Street west side of school (7:42 am) OR at High School driveway north side of school (7:45 am) – (NOTE: Johnson Street is a one-way street, with no traffic allowed while buses are loading/unloading)
 - i. Bus #11 – 6th and 8th grades going to Middle School in Wenona
 - ii. Bus #5 – 7th grade going to Middle School in Wenona
 - iii. Bus #7 – 5th grade going to Intermediate School in Toluca
 - iv. Bus #10 – 3rd and 4th grades going to Intermediate School in Toluca
 - b. Shuttles loading at Intermediate School in Toluca
 - i. Bus #21 – 7th and 8th grades going to Middle School in Wenona – load in circle drive
 - ii. Bus #20 – 6th grade going to Middle School in Wenona – load in circle drive
 - iii. Bus #9 – HS students going to High School in Minonk – load in circle drive
 - iv. Bus #19 – HS students going to High School in Minonk – load in circle drive
 - v. Bus #6 – K, 1st, and 2nd grades going to Primary School in Minonk – load by band room door on south side of building – Monitor Sherrie Persic will help students load/unload and will be present for supervision purposes for ~30 minutes before loading in morning and after unloading in the afternoon
 - c. Shuttles loading at Middle School in Wenona – all buses load on north side of building
 - i. Bus #16 – HS students going to High School in Minonk
 - ii. Bus #2 – HS students going to High School in Minonk
 - iii. Bus #3 – K, 1st, and 2nd grades going to Primary School in Minonk – Monitor Jerrod Barth will help students load/unload and will be present for supervision purposes for ~30 minutes before loading in morning and after unloading in the afternoon
 - iv. Bus #14 – 3rd and 4th grades going to Intermediate School in Toluca
 - v. Bus #17 – 5th grade students going to Intermediate School in Toluca
3. Parents will not be allowed to drive or park in the loading zone for buses at any school during loading/unloading times.
4. Afternoon shuttles will reverse the order noted above, with student drop-off in home towns at approximately 3:30-3:35 pm.
